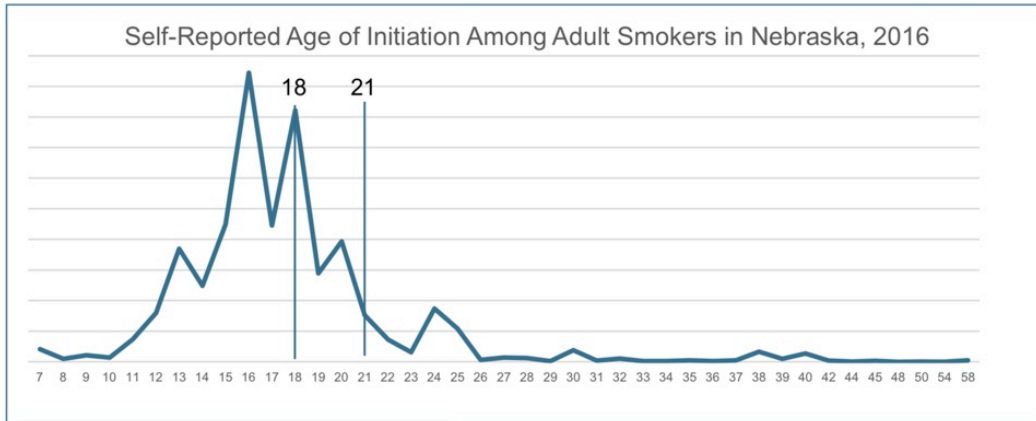
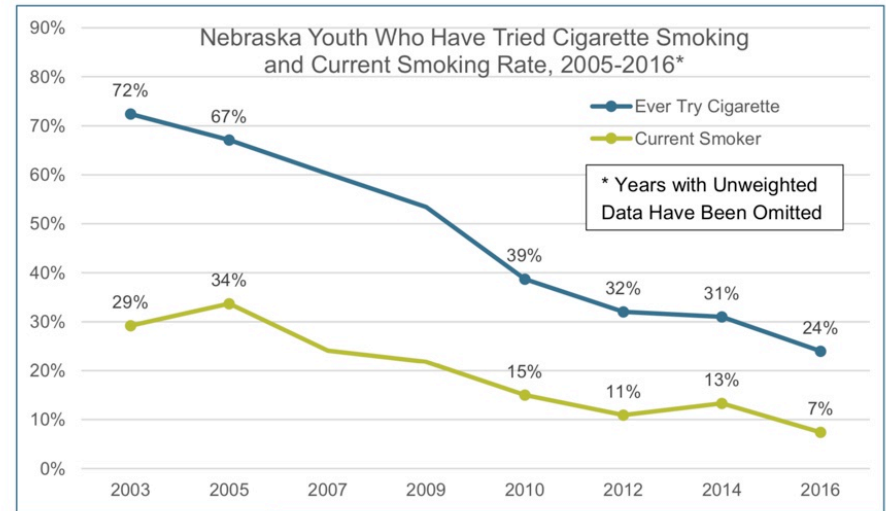


Primary Prevention – Tobacco Products

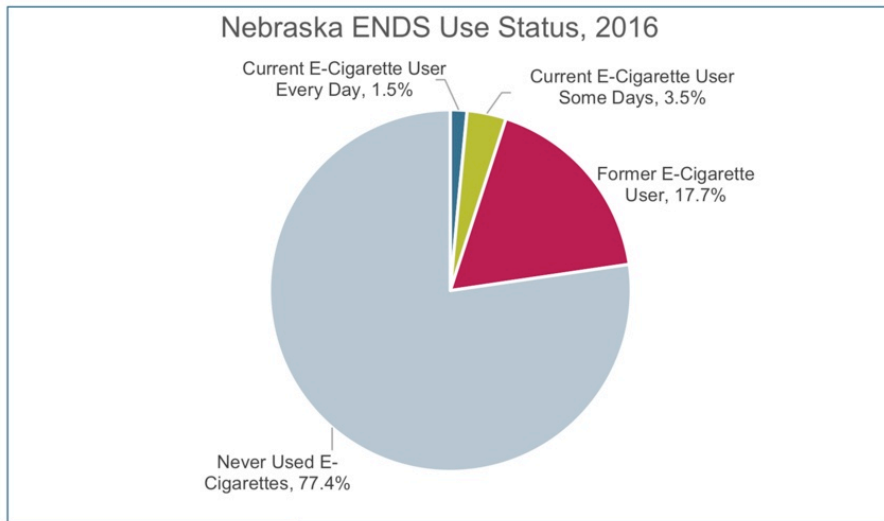
The 2016 Nebraska Adult Tobacco Survey found that 73% of adult Nebraska smokers indicate they began smoking before age 18 and nearly all by the age of 21.

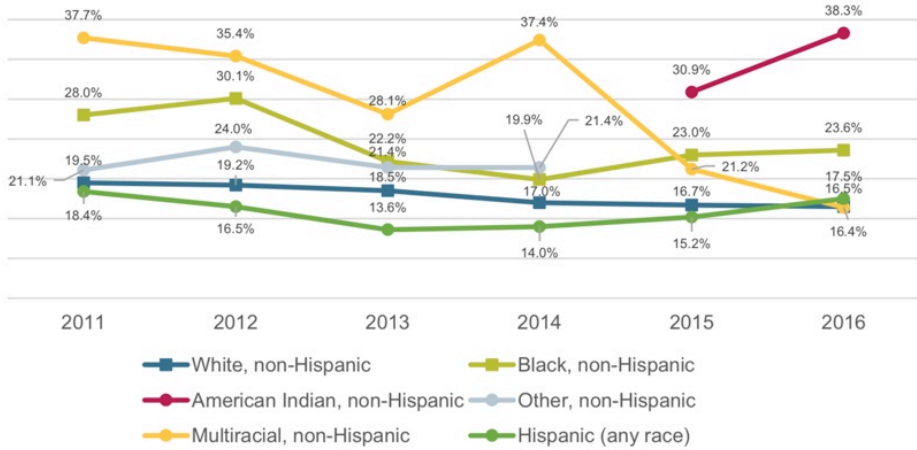

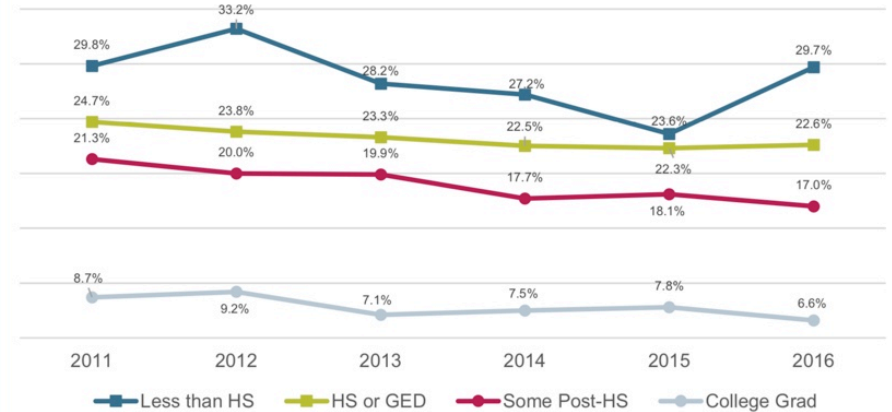


Nebraska Adult Cigarette Smoking by Race/Ethnicity 2011-2016



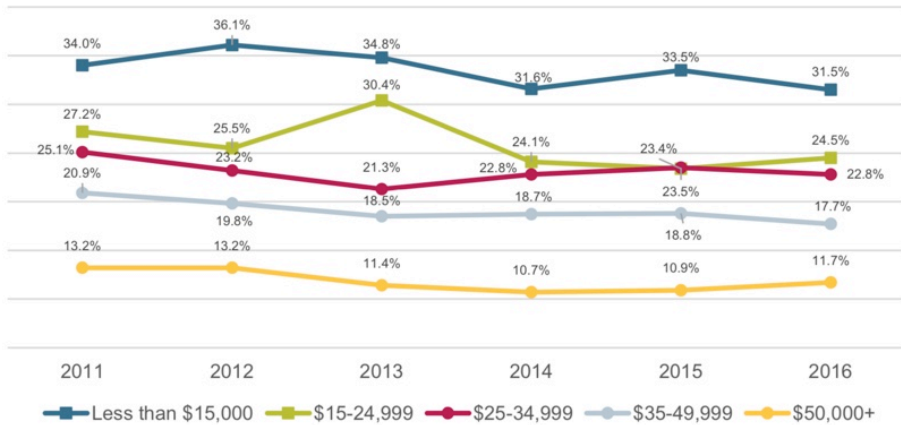

Nebraska Adult Cigarette Smoking by Education Attainment, 2011-2016



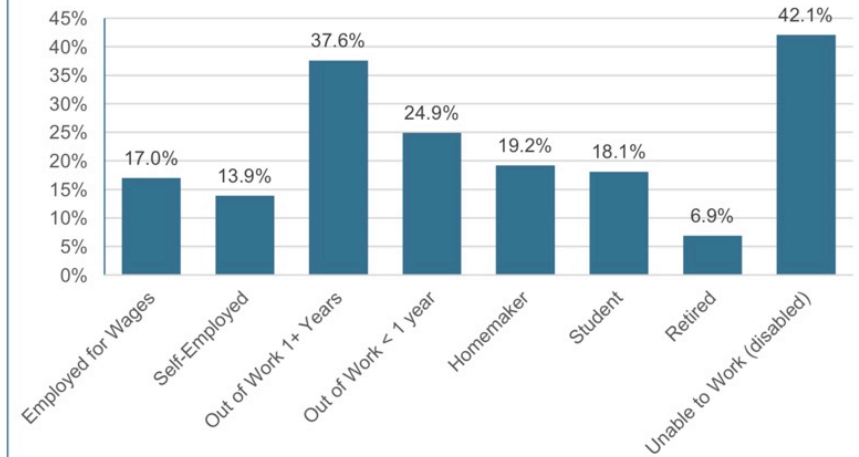
